### Notes

1. The tuition fee is stated after applying a discretionary bursary of £1,291 to the full fee of £6,396. Additional bursaries may be available in certain cases and requests should be made to the Executive Director.
  
2. The maintenance/amenities fee is stated after applying a bursary of £463 for residential students and £914 for non-residential students. The fee covers the provision of general college facilities and, in the case of residential students, the provision of term-time board and lodging. Annual rebates are granted as follows:

3. Single students living in context in college-managed accommodation pay a supplement of £315 in view of accommodation available to them in the vacations as well as term-time (normally charged at £1,050) set against a rebate for food not taken in college (£735).
  
4. Non-residential students are entitled to:
  - (i) college-managed houses or flats at rates generally below the market and in most cases exempt from Council tax
  - (ii) week-day lunches and some evening meals
  - (iii) access to the college day nursery at preferential rates
  
5. The validation fee is payable annually by students registered on programmes validated by the University of Bristol.
  
6. Students for whom it is agreed that they should follow an ordination ministerial training programme or equivalent are subject to an additional fee.
  
7. Some UK candidates aged under 30 may be eligible for the college's 4S scheme (special student scholarship scheme) in the case of one-year certificate courses only. Under this scheme the aggregate tuition and residential maintenance fee (after bursary) is reduced by 50%.

### **Notes**

1. A course will be deemed to be half-time for its duration. Hence a student admitted to the course and taking 80 credits in year one and 40 credits in year 2 will be charged half-time fees in both years. Half and part-time students are not normally eligible for pastoral group membership.
2. An additional charge is made for meals taken in college (note the exception below concerning Certificate students – note 4). Residence in college is possible by arrangement through the Executive Director in which case the standard residential maintenance fee becomes payable (see full-time fees).
3. Students registered on a university-validated undergraduate programme pay an annual validation fee: one half of the full-time validation fee in the case of half-time and part-time certificate students and one third in the case of other part-time students.
4. The part-time Certificate in Theology is available from September 2009 and is being charged at a preferential introductory rate. Spouses of full-time students are charged at 50%. Where weekend attendance is required meals are included in the fee.
5. Students following the per credit route are subject to an enrolment maximum per year of modules totalling 50 credits (note different maximum for student spouses – page 7).
6. Part-time students resident in college for periods of one or two terms may take up to 60 credits before they are deemed half-time. This will apply, for example, to students visiting from colleges overseas.
7. All per annum fees are subject to an inflationary increase in subsequent years.

## Notes to Full-time Postgraduate Courses

1. MA extensions may be granted by the college for up to a maximum of one year. The tuition and validation fees are charged at one half of the standard fee for the duration of the extension. The normal maintenance fee continues to apply, except in the case of extramural extensions.
2. Students who enrol on the PGDip with a view to proceeding to the MA are charged from the outset as MA candidates, with retrospective adjustment if not upgraded.
3. Where the MA or PGDip is preceded by the Induction Semester full MA or PGDip fees continue to be charged for the period from September to December of the following year, subject to the normal annual increase.
4. The validation fee is payable annually by students registered on programmes validated by the University of Bristol.
5. The residential maintenance fee covers standard Trinity terms only. Self-catering accommodation can be arranged for normal Trinity vacation periods at vacation rates (see Accommodation & Meals). This is stated after applying a bursary of £463.
6. The non-residential maintenance fee relates to the general provision of college facilities, including eligibility for places at the college day nursery at subsidised rates. Students on the lower rate pay additionally for meals taken in college. The higher rate fee gives entitlement to:
  - (i) week-day lunches and some evening meals in College free of charge
  - (ii) College houses/flats for which the rent is typically below market rates and on which, in most cases, no Council tax is generally payable
7. MPhil, MLitt and PhD tuition and validation fees are charged respectively for 12 months, 2-3 years and 3-4 years, according to the length of time the student remains under supervision. Thereafter a reduced termly extension fee of one half the standard tuition and validation fees becomes payable where an extension has been agreed. The maintenance fee continues to be payable. There is no reduction for early completion.
8. In the final year students also incur charges for printing and binding theses. Actual costs may vary depending upon the size of the thesis but an estimate of the costs for submission and final printing for the required number of copies (which must be paid in advance to the University of Bristol) is as follows:

## Notes to Part-time Postgraduate Courses

1. Part-time postgraduate courses are normally only available to UK and EU citizens or others who do not require full-time study status for visa purposes as well as to those studying at a distance whilst based overseas.
2. Meals taken in College are charged at normal student rates (see Accommodation & Meals).
3. Any accommodation required by part-time postgraduate students during course teaching weeks is charged at normal student rates (see Accommodation & Meals).
4. Where study continues beyond the normal payment period (MA 2 years; MPhil 2 years; MLitt 4-6 years; PhD 6-8 years) and an extension is granted, an extension fee is charged of one-half of the standard part-time tuition and validation fee.
5. All fees including part-time are subject to an increase in subsequent years.
6. It is important to note that a minimum fee is payable for all postgraduate programmes taken part-time irrespective of the number of years taken to complete. It is equal to the aggregate of the tuition, validation and amenities fees over 2 or 3 years (MA), 2 years (MPhil), 4 years (MLitt), and 6 years (PhD).
7. The validation fee is payable annually by students registered on programmes validated by the University of Bristol.
8. Printing and binding costs – please see note 8 on page 4, which also applies to part-time students.

*Note:* Spouses of full-time students following this route instead of the part-time Certificate in Theology (see Part-time undergraduate courses) are subject to an enrolment maximum per year of modules totalling 80 credits. Spouses registered on university-validated courses are subject to the standard validation fee (see Part-time undergraduate courses).

### **Full-time study at postgraduate level**

Spouses of full-time students wishing to study for an MA are eligible for a 50% bursary on the MA tuition fee (ie the full tuition fee is reduced by half). In addition, they pay the standard non-residential maintenance/amenities fee together with the full validation fee. No reductions are normally available for research degrees.

## Accommodation

### *Carter*

- Full board and lodging (during college terms) 140 per week
- Self-catering (during college vacations) 70 per week

Where a couple occupy a double or twin room the charge is reduced by £35 per week for the second person.

### *The Lodge*

- Self-catering (all year)
  - single occupancy 210 per week
  - double occupancy 265 per week

Four weeks are charged at the price of three where a booking is initially made for four weeks or more. Lunch and supper may be taken in the college dining room when available at £4.20 and £3.40 per head respectively.

## Tuition and Study

For a weekly fee of £50 guests on residential or non-residential sabbaticals may be assigned the guidance of a tutor for their private study. (The amount is subject to variation depending on the level of involvement agreed.) Auditing lectures whilst on sabbatical is free of charge. However, where a person wishes to register for a particular course and be assessed normal course fees apply.

## Chapel and Library

Sabbatical guests are welcome to take part in college worship and to use the library for reading (though not borrowing) at no extra charge.
